This brochure provides information about Boy Scout Camp Outpost Meal Program. Troops and Crews will be given the option of cooking more than one meal in the campsite by either ordering a prepackage meal or individual food items to prepare a meal of their choice. The prepackage meals or individual food items will be supplied by the Food Service vendor. Please read this brochure carefully and follow the instructions for ordering.

This meal program is designed to be used by the unit in conducting the Cooking Merit Badge program and completing the cooking requirements from Tenderfoot to First Class.

HOW TO ORDER

Section 1-Unit Food Order Budget

Complete this section to determine your allowed Outpost Food Order budget dollar amount. The number of youth and adults must equal those registered on campsite roster at the Sunday check in. All units will be required to cook in their campsite on Wednesday evening. The outpost meal program will not be available for Sunday Dinner, Monday Breakfast, Friday Dinner and Saturday Breakfast.

Section 2-Unit Food Pickup Orders

Units ordering individual food items must use the Pick-up Order Forms. Please enter the individual items from the list on pages 2 & 3 from the Outpost Meal Program Guide on the Pickup Form for your desired pickup day and time. Please order paper and dry goods on your first pickup by using the appropriate pickup order form. Units purchasing prepackage meals must use section 3.

Section 3-Unit Food Order Summary

Enter the dollar amount for each of the pickup forms on the corresponding Total Cost line (lines 6-14). Those units ordering prepackage meals will enter their choices, quantities and dollar amount on the corresponding pickup time line (lines 6a-14a). Add lines 6 through 14a and enter on line 15. If line 15 is more than line 5, the difference is entered on line 17 and is payable the Katahdin Area Council when submitting your Unit Food Order.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Each unit is responsible for bringing to camp the equipment needed to participate in this outpost cooking program. Each unit will need a storage box, ice box/chest and large container for mixing bug juice. Ice will be sold at the Trading Post (cubes or blocks). Each unit needs to bring the necessary cleaning supplies for proper cleaning of cooking dishes and utensils. Please follow all of the recommended BSA safe food handling practices and policies. All units are required to deposit the garbage after each meal in the designated dumpster behind the Dining Hall. Garbage bags are available from the quartermaster during the daily pickup times.

PICK-UP TIMES

All outpost food orders will be issued to the units from the back of the dining hall. Times will be Monday thru Friday 9am and 2pm only (*please be prompt*). A person from Jeff's Catering or the Dining Hall Steward will be in charge of the food order distribution.
