



WHAT SHOULD I BRING TO CAMP.....

Cub Scouts

- Flashlight
- Extra Batteries
- Swimsuit/shorts
- 2 towels
- Wolf/Bear/Webelos Handbook
- Pencil/pens
- Notebook
- Complete Cub Scout/Webelos Uniform
- Water Bottle/Canteen
- Rain Gear
- Bug Spray and Sunscreen
- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Small Backpack (to carry gear around camp)
- Jacket/Sweatshirt
- Scouting T-shirts
- 3 extra each shorts & pants
- Extra shoes (hiking boots/sneakers, NO OPEN TOED SHOES)
- 3 extra sets of underwear
- 6 extra pairs of socks
- Personal toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, comb, washcloth)
- Pajamas or something else to sleep in.
- COSTUMES FOR THEME DAY GAMES & PARADE
- Completed Medical Forms
- Prescription Medication

Optional Items:

- Shower Shoes
- Knife (must meet BSA regulations, check with Scout Leaders first)
- Camera
- Fishing Pole & tackle
- Musical Instrument
- Books, Deck of cards
- Personal Snacks
- Spending money for Scout Store
- Sheet for camp cots
- Bug Net

LEADERS' EQUIPMENT:

In addition to the list of equipment above, leaders may want to consider having the following items.

- Camp Chair
- Clipboard or notebook for carrying notes and handouts
- Small backpack to carry items around camp
- Songbooks, Campfire story books, book of skits
- Camp Lantern
- Camp stove and other equipment needed for campsite cooking
- Theme costumes and games for theme time

WHAT NOT TO BRING: The following items are NOT allowed at camp: pets, drugs, alcohol, firearms/ammunition, personal archery equipment and fireworks. Please do not allow the boys to bring TV's, personal music players, hand held electronic games, cell phones, ect. Remember they are at Camp to enjoy the GREAT OUTDOORS!
