Important:

Scout fees must be paid in full two weeks prior to the Unit's attendance or a \$25 per Scout late fee will be assessed to the "Regular Fee."

To receive the Early Bird Fee – Scout fees must be paid in full by April 15, 2021.

Campership applications must be submitted on or before April 15, 2021, and will be considered Early Birds. Talk with your Leader about this opportunity.
